HEAD-ON COLLISION CLOSES PORTION OF ROADWAY FOR HOURS

SUFFOLK, Virginia (May 9, 2014) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to a head-on collision that occurred this evening at 6:39 p.m. at the intersection of Manning Road and Copeland Road in rural Suffolk.

The white Ford overturned and the male driver was airlifted by Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with what are believed to be non-life threatening injuries.

The female driver of the second vehicle, a Jeep Liberty, had to be extricated from the vehicle and was ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with what are believed to be non-life threatening injuries.

Both drivers were the sole occupants of the involved vehicles.

The road was closed at the intersection for approximately two hours as the investigation continued and the vehicles and debris were removed from the roadway.

Battalion 1, Engines 2 and 4, Rescue 1, EMS 1, Medics 1A and 2A, and the Nansemond Suffolk Volunteer Rescue Squad responded to the scene.
