SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK WANTED PERSON IN CONNECTION WITH COUNTERFEIT U.S. CURRENCY

SUFFOLK, VA (July 29, 2014) The Suffolk Police Department is asking for the public's assistance in locating a wanted person who is accused of passing counterfeit U. S. currency.

Chiquita Monique Adams, age 38, of Suffolk, is wanted on eight felony counts of uttering a false bank note and one felony count of embezzlement.

The offense occurred on May 9, 2014 when Chiquita Adams allegedly swapped true U. S. currency for counterfeit bills during the course of her employment at Bojangles restaurant on Bridge Road in Suffolk. The counterfeit bills were caught by the restaurant management who immediately contacted police. None of the counterfeit bills were passed to the restaurant guests.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court.

Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the [TipSubmit mobile app](#). Tips can be submitted by visiting www.tipsubmit.com, or by texting the

word **“CRIMES”** (274637) with the keyword **SPDVATIP**. TipSoft also supports users’ ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
