SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK HIT AND RUN SUSPECT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 19, 2014) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect involved in a hit and run which occurred in the 900 block of North Main Street on June 14, 2014 at approximately 2:33 p.m.

The suspect is described as a black male in his late 20's to mid30's. He is approximately 6'3" and was wearing a white shirt, tan boots and camouflage pants. He is further described as having close cropped hair and a thin beard.

Surveillance cameras captured images of the suspect while he was in the Rent-N-Roll. The suspect's vehicle struck another vehicle in the parking lot after he exited the store causing extensive damage. The suspect then fled the scene. He was driving a burgundy/maroon GMC Yukon SUV, model year early 2000's, with North Carolina tags with the first digits either OK or OC, and the last 3 digits 060. No one was injured during the incident.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. TipSoft also supports users’ ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
