SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK BREAKING AND ENTERING SUSPECT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 19, 2014) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect involved in a Breaking and Entering of a Business which occurred in the 2000 block of Meade Parkway sometime between Saturday afternoon, May 24th, and Tuesday morning, May 27, 2014.

Officers were called to the scene of Quality Time Child Care when the business reopened on May 27, 2014 after the forced entry to the business was discovered. Electronic equipment, a gaming system and laptop computer were stolen.

The suspect as seen on surveillance video is described as a black male in his mid to late 20's. He is approximately 6' to 6'1", weighing approximately 200 pounds, and was wearing a black shirt, long khaki cargo shorts, and had long dreadlocks that were visible underneath a black head covering.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the [TipSubmit mobile app](#). Tips can be submitted by visiting www.tipsubmit.com, or by texting the word “**CRIMES**” (274637) with the keyword **SPDVATIP**. TipSoft also supports users’ ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
