THREE VEHICLE ACCIDENT ON PRUDEN BOULEVARD/ROUTE 460

SUFFOLK, VA (September 16, 2014) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue are on the scene of a three vehicle accident on Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 at General Early Drive. Emergency Dispatchers were notified of the incident at 12:33 p.m.

The preliminary investigation indicates that a minivan traveling westbound on Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 was attempting to turn right onto General Early Drive and was struck from the rear by a pickup truck. A third vehicle attempted to avoid the accident and went into a roadside ditch.

No injuries were reported following preliminary emergency medical assessment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel. All motorists declined treatment.

Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 currently has one eastbound lane and one westbound lane closed with traffic flowing in the open lanes. The roadway is expected to be open within the next 20 to 30 minutes.
