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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 3, 2014) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, July 3, 2014, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Lewis Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Lewis Avenue closed between Spruce Street and Cedar Street Extended until 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and the North Carolina Line from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Turlington Road and Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood) – A contractor will be working in the roadway and the right-of-way along Turlington Road and within Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood as part of the sewer improvements for this neighborhood. Anticipate temporary lane closures along Turlington Road and detoured traffic within the neighborhood while the gravity sewer is being constructed. This work should be completed by November 1, 2014.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will be working in the roadway and the right-of-way along Kings Highway between Bob House Parkway and the former Kings Highway Bridge installing a 12-inch sewer force main. Anticipate temporary lane closures in the area of construction. This work should be completed by August 1, 2014.

(Lawson Circle) – City of Suffolk Public Utilities Contractor will have a road closure in the 1300 block of Lawson Circle from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, from June 19, 2014 to August 20, 2014. Residents east of the closure will need to enter and exit their properties from the east while residents west of the closure will need to enter and exit their properties from the west during working hours.

(Kings Highway and Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will be working in the roadway and right-of-way along Kings Highway and Sleepy Hole Road from the demolished Kings Highway Bridge to the Nansemond River Drive intersection installing a 12-inch sewer force main. Beginning June 9, 2014, expect work at the intersection of Kings Highway and Sleepy Hole Road. Anticipate temporary lane closures in the area of construction. This work should be completed by August 1, 2014.

(Various locations) – A contractor will be working on the installation of water and sewer mains for the Crittenden/Eclipse water and sewer extension project. The work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The project will be ongoing until Spring 2015. Flagging operations will be necessary on the following streets: Wigneil Street, Vine Street, Pike Street, Rivershore Drive, Dixon Road, Cross Street, Eclipse Drive, Bleakhorn Drive, and Darden Clubhouse Road during the period of construction.

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
