SUFFOLK, VA (July 9, 2012) The super load move scheduled for today, Monday, July 9, 2012, has been postponed until Tuesday, July 10, 2012 at 1:30 p.m.

POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 6, 2012) A super load move involving two sections of a modular home could cause delays in traffic Monday, July 9, 2012, between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m.

The truck moving the modular home sections will start the move in North Carolina on Route 258 and travel from the Franklin Bypass to Route 58 eastbound to Route 13/58/460/Suffolk Bypass to Route 10/Godwin Boulevard to Route 125/Kings Highway to Route 628/6300 block of Crittenden Road.

The load will measure 15 feet tall, 15 feet wide, 98 feet long and will weigh 54,000 pounds.
