DOMINION VIRGINIA POWER ADVISES OF EMERGENCY DOWNTOWN TRANSFORMER REPLACEMENT

SUFFOLK, VA (April 10, 2015) Dominion Virginia Power has just advised the City that they must perform an emergency transformer replacement this weekend. The work location is at the northwest corner of the intersection of West Washington Street and North Main Street in downtown Suffolk.

Due to the nature of this work, Dominion Virginia Power will be having multiple outages at varying times from Saturday, April 11, 2015 at 10:00 p.m. until Monday,

April 13, 2015 at 6:00 a.m. along West Washington Street between and near the cross streets of North Main Street and Saratoga Street. Dominion Virginia Power will have West Washington Street blocked to traffic between North Main Street and Saratoga Street with traffic detours in place. Dominion Virginia Power will take extreme care to work with individuals that need to access properties within this block, and will work safely to protect the public in the work area.
