MEET SUFFOLK HISTORIAN KERMIT HOBBS AND LEARN ABOUT THE MURDER OF "GRAC" JONES

SUFFOLK, VA (April 13, 2016) Meet Kermit Hobbs, Suffolk Historian and author of "The Murder of Tiberius Gracchus Jones", at the Morgan Memorial Library, located at 443 West Washington Street, from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Saturday April 30th. Hobbs will talk about his book which tells the story of the 1908 murder in Holland, Virginia.

The first chapter of Hobbs' piece was published in the *Suffolk News-Herald* in July 2015 and was serialized throughout the summer. The book version, which will be available at the event to purchase, includes additions such as photographs, newspaper clippings, maps and author's commentary.
