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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (April 19, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, April 19, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Greenway Road and Herman Court from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will be maintaining vegetation along Route 58 between Holland and the Route 13 Bypass.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile flagging operation on Route 58 from the Holland Road intersection to the Wilroy Road exit until 3 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed to thru traffic between Halifax Street and Lloyd Street until 3 p.m. Resident and emergency vehicle access will be provided.

(Greenway Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Greenway Road between Cypress Chapel Road and Wedgewood Drive until 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Route 10/Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound shoulder closure on Route 10/Godwin Boulevard between the Reids Ferry Bridge and 1000 feet north of the pump station. They will also have a lane closure in the northbound lane from Sack Point Road to Harrell Drive from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. This pipe installation project will continue for the next three to five months.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Market Street & Henley Place) – Thru traffic on Market Street and Henley Place will be restricted beginning Tuesday, March 26 through Friday, April 26 due to utilities installation for the new E-911/Municipal Center project. The west entrance to the Main Municipal Center Parking Lot will be closed. All public and staff traffic to the Human Resources Building will utilize the same entrance and travel along the north side of the parking lot to the building. Access to the Human

Resources Building can also happen via Washington Street to Pender Street on the west side of the Police Administration Building.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains. The expected completion date is September 2013.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.

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
