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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (April 25, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, April 25, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will be conducting tree clearing along Nansemond Parkway from Helen Street to the Suffolk/Chesapeake City limits. Travelers should be aware of equipment moving along and adjacent to the roadway and intermittently crossing into the roadway. Work will take place Monday thru Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue until further notice.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on southbound Nansemond Parkway near the entrance to Mack Benn Elementary School for pavement widening from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will be working on Katherine Street installing gas lines from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will be performing work on Wilroy Road between Progress Road and Nansemond Parkway at the bridge overnight on April 25, 2016 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. In the event of inclement weather, the work will be rescheduled. A detour will be in place and a variable message board will be in place to alert the traveling public.

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Charlotte Avenue closed between Spruce Street and Dill Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Kings Fork Road between Godwin Boulevard and Quarter Horse Road overnight from 5 p.m. to 6 a.m., April 25 thru April 29.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard between Kings Highway and the 6200 block for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Milners Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Milners Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Longstreet Lane between Pittmantown Road and Route 58 for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 1200 to 1600 block of northbound North Main Street for a sidewalk install from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on West Washington Street from Wellons Street to South Street overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(West Washington Street and North Saratoga Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have traffic control provided by Suffolk Police at the intersection of West Washington Street and North Saratoga Street for utility work from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Market Street and North Saratoga Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have traffic control provided by Suffolk Police at the intersection of Market Street and North Saratoga Street for utility work from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Burnetts Way) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Burnetts Way from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on eastbound Route 58 Business for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Manning Road between West Liberty Spring Road and Shellito Lane from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 13) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 13 for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound right lane shift in the 600 block of Harbour View Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will have Katherine Street closed between East Pinner Street and East Constance Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice.

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
