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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (April 28, 2014) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, April 28, 2014, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Lewis Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of Lewis Avenue closed between Spruce Street and Laurel Street while storm drains are installed until 3 p.m.

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have lane closures on Route 58/Holland Road at Pioneer Road between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway and Shoulders Hill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Signal Crews will be conducting maintenance on the signals at Nansemond Parkway and Shoulders Hill Road. All approaches will be affected with intermittent mobile lane closures from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 between Old Myrtle Road and Lake Prince Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(South Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure at the 300 block of South Main Street for utility work. Traffic control will be setup from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will be maintaining vegetation on Route 58/Holland Road between the Southwestern Bypass and the Village of Holland.

(Old Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the bridge on Old Mill Road between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail closed from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Copeland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Copeland Road between Manning Road and Whaleyville Boulevard from 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on West Washington Street between North Main Street and Saratoga Street as they resurface the milled roadway. Work will conclude when the resurfacing is completed or when precipitation begins, whichever comes first.

Ongoing Projects:

(Holland Road/Route 58) – A contractor is completing construction of a 16-inch water main along the outer lanes of Holland Road/Route 58 at the Village of Holland. Expect temporary shoulder closures along the corridor from the Center Point Development to the Village of Holland as the contractor completes water main testing and shoulder repairs.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will be working in the roadway and the right-of-way along Kings Highway between Bob House Parkway and the former Kings Highway Bridge installing a 12-inch sewer force main. Anticipate temporary lane closures in the area of construction. This work should be completed by July 1, 2014.

(Kings Highway and Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will be working in the roadway and right-of-way along Kings Highway and Sleepy Hole Road from the demolished Kings Highway Bridge to the Nansemond River Drive intersection installing a 12-inch sewer force main. Anticipate temporary lane closures in the area of construction. This work should be completed by July 1, 2014.

(Various locations) – A contractor will be working on the installation of water and sewer mains for the Crittenden/Eclipse water and sewer extension project. The work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The project will be ongoing until Spring 2015. Flagging operations will be necessary on the following streets: Wigneil Street, Vine Street, Pike Street, Rivershore Drive, Dixon Road, Cross Street, Eclipse Drive, Bleakhorn Drive, and Darden Clubhouse Road during the period of construction.

(Johnson Lane) – Johnson Lane will be closed indefinitely to provide construction access to the proposed Walgreens site along Constance Road.

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
