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UPDATE

(Route 58 Bypass) – A contractor will be working on the westbound Route 58 Bypass past the truck scales. The right lane will be closed from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 12, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, August 12, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a northbound lane closure in the 3300 block of Bridge Road for bridge maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Airport Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Airport Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and Airport Court from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Burbage Lake Village) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation in Burbage Lake Village (Burbage Lake Circle and side streets off Burbage Lake Circle) from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be conducting bridge inspections at the following locations: eastbound and westbound in the 4000 block of Godwin Boulevard, northbound and southbound in the 3300 block of Bridge Road, northbound and southbound on the Route 13/32 Bypass, and Pinner Street. This work may require alternating shoulder and/or lane closures during work hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 8th through August 12th.

(Main Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on the northbound outside lane on Main Street between the 1700 block of Main Street to Murphys Mill Road between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Ridgewood Village) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation in Ridgewood Village (Ivanhoe Court, Dickens Court E & W, and Leyton Place) from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 11th through August 19th.

(South Quay Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on South Quay Road (Route 189 and Route 272) for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on northbound North Main Street between the 1700 block and Northgate Lane from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pearl Street) – A contractor will have Pearl Street closed for a utility repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. with a detour in place.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 58 from the Southampton line to Holland Road for vegetation maintenance on the shoulders from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pinner Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on northbound Pinner Street between the 100 block to 8000 block from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a southbound lane closure in the morning switching to a northbound left lane closure in the afternoon on the Route 13/32 Bypass over Lake Kilby for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour set to be established the week of August 15, 2016. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be locating manholes or mainline cleanouts at the following locations: 2800 block of Pruden Boulevard, East Pinner Street (near Moore Avenue), North Main Street, 300 block of Carolina Road, and 600 block of West Washington Street (near Broad Street). This work will be performed August 15th through August 17th during the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be locating manholes or mainline cleanouts at the following locations: Holladay Street, Park Way, Central Avenue, Eugenia Street, Day Street, Polk Street, Moore Avenue, Madison Avenue, Walnut Street, West Riverview Drive, Pelham Place, Park Road, Lincoln Avenue, and Bosley Avenue. This work will be performed August 17th through August 19th during the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be conducting overhead span sign inspections throughout the City of Suffolk, August 15th through August 26th. Locations include College Drive, Route 17, Route 58, Route 13, Portsmouth Boulevard, Route 10, and Route 460. The inspections will require alternating lane closures during the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Charlotte Avenue closed between Laurel Street and Lewis Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will have Katherine Street closed to thru traffic between East Pinner Street and East Constance Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work in this area is expected to continue through September 23rd.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice.

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
