POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE FRIDAY MORNING

SUFFOLK, Virginia (August 24, 2012) The Department of Public Works would like to make you aware of a super load move that could possibly cause a delay in traffic Friday morning.

Two super loads carrying sections of a modular home measuring 15' high, 14' wide and 71' long, each weighing 54,000 pounds, will be traveling from Newport News along US58 West, and will then travel US 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass, to 13/32 Bypass and then Route 13 North to Dill Road, then County Street, then Mill Street, and then arriving at the final destination on Spruce Street.

Delays may be experienced when transferring the modular home to the property at Spruce Street.

The move will have front and rear pilot cars.
