POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE

SUFFOLK, VA (August 26, 2016) A super load move, involving the hauling of a crane, could cause delays in traffic at 11 a.m., Monday, August 29, 2016.

The truck will begin its journey in the 4600 block of Girl Scout Road and will travel to Matoaka Road to Kings Fork Road and will end its journey in the 4200 block of Godwin Boulevard.

The truck and load will measure 16 feet tall, 17 feet 11 inches wide, 100 feet long, and weigh 230,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police escorts.
