### **SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT PORTSMOUTH BOULEVARD**

SUFFOLK, VA (May 6, 2017) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel responded earlier this morning to a single vehicle accident in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard/Route 58. Emergency Communications received the call at approximately 11:15 a.m. notifying of the accident involving a Ford SUV.

Upon preliminary investigation it was found that the vehicle was traveling on Portsmouth Boulevard when it left the roadway and collided with trees.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment and the adult female driver was ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries, and a 3-year-old male was ground transported to CHKD suffering from serious injuries.

A portion of the roadway had been closed immediately following the accident and all lanes reopened at 2:10 p.m. The cause of the accident remains under investigation.
