### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (December 1, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, December 1, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure in the 1300-1400 block of Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the inside lanes north and southbound and the two-way left turn lane closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road. This closure will be in place 24 hours per day, November 16<sup>th</sup> through December 2<sup>nd</sup>.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures in the 5900 block of Godwin Boulevard for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 600 block of Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Crittenden Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Crittenden Road at Cotton Farm Lane for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation westbound on Route 58 for vegetation maintenance from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

(Lane Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Lane Street for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating northbound lane closures on Bridge Road between Bennetts Creek Lane and the bridge for a milling operation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 WB) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 westbound and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a January 2017 completion date.

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
