ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (December 2, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, December 2, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the inside lanes north and southbound and the two-way left turn lane closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road. This closure will be in place 24 hours per day, December 2nd through December 5th.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 600 block of Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a westbound lane closure in the 5200 block of Godwin Boulevard for a washout repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure in the 2200 block of Wilroy Road for a washout repair at the bridge from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(East Constance Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 200 block of East Constance Road for pothole repair from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating northbound lane closures on Bridge Road between Bennetts Creek Lane and the bridge for milling and paving operation daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., December 1st through December 5th. Sunday, December 4th, there will be alternating lane closures at the bridge tapers for paving and milling overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather permitting.

Upcoming Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have the westbound right lane closed on Route 58 at the scales for pavement restoration from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., December 5th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 WB) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 westbound and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a January 2017 completion date.
