### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (December 3, 2012) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, December 3, 2012, due to construction and maintenance projects:

**New Projects:**

(Hillpoint Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Engineering Division will have a lane closure on Hillpoint Road at Hillpoint Elementary School from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Flaggers will be in place at both entrances to the school. This closure will extend into Tuesday morning for approximately two hours.

(Centerpoint Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Signal Department will have a short term stationary lane closure affecting the westbound right turn late into Centerpoint Drive from Holland Road/Route 58 from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Wilroy Road from Suburban Drive to Portsmouth Boulevard until 3 p.m.

(Manning Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Manning Road between Copeland Road and Quaker Drive until 3 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will be performing utility work within the 400 block of West Washington Street. West Washington Street, extending from Wellons Street to Chesnut Street, will be closed to thru traffic from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Wednesday, November 28 to Friday, December 14. Access to local businesses within the work zone will be provided. Access to the Morgan Memorial Library is available from Jackson Street.

(Mineral Spring Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Mineral Spring Road between Sumner Street and Robertson Street, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., through December 2012.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains.

(Route 10) - Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Route 10 between Everets Road and Kings Highway until 3 p.m. This work zone is an ongoing project set for completion by the end of December 2012.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.
