ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (December 4, 2014) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, December 4, 2014, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(East Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane shift on East Washington Street between North Lloyd Street and North Division Street from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Sleepy Hole Road between Kings Highway and Nansemond Parkway from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Spivey Run Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Spivey Run Road between Freeman Mill Road and Arthur Drive from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering's paint crew will have the center lane closed on Rt. 58 between Staley Drive and Kenyon Road from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Indian Trail) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 3000 - 4000 block of Indian Trail from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bay Circle) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Bay Circle from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Turlington Road) – The Turlington Road Sewer Extension Project is planned to run through April 2015, 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The work will require the closure of Turlington Road to thru traffic between Jackson Road and Old Somerton Road. Access for local traffic including the Turlington Woods Alternative School and emergency vehicles will be provided.

(Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood) – A contractor is working within the Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood as part of the sewer improvements for this neighborhood. Work is being conducted on Austin and Lake Speight Drives. Anticipate detoured traffic in the neighborhood as the gravity sewer is being constructed. This work should be completed by February 1, 2015.

(Robbie Road) – The Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will begin working on the bridge along Robbie Road, beginning on August 28, 2014. The project will require the closure of the roadway at the bridge site with work expected to be completed by December 10, 2014. A detour will be in place to route thru traffic.

(Manning Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations and a contractor will work on the bridge along Manning Bridge Road beginning Monday, July 28, 2014. The project will require the closure of the roadway at the bridge site and

work is expected to be completed by December 5, 2014. A detour will be in place to route thru traffic.

(Various locations) – A contractor will be working on the installation of water and sewer mains for the Crittenden/Eclipse water and sewer extension project. The work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The project will be ongoing until spring 2015. Flagging operations will be necessary on the following streets: Wigneil Street, Vine Street, Pike Street, Rivershore Drive, Dixon Road, Cross Street, Eclipse Drive, Bleakhorn Drive, and Darden Clubhouse Road during the period of construction

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
