FIRE DESTROYS MOTOR HOME

SUFFOLK, Virginia (January 22, 2017) Suffolk Fire & Rescue crews responded earlier this evening to a fire in the 2600 block of Manning Road.

Emergency Communications received the call at 8:48 p.m. advising of a fire involving a motor home at the rural residence off Route 58, and the first units were on scene at 8:59 p.m.

Battalion Chief William Kessinger advised that upon arrival crews found the RV, which was located under a shelter, fully engulfed. The fire was extinguished and did not extend to any of the surrounding structures. The fire was called under control at 9:14 p.m. and the motor home was declared a total loss. No one was inside the RV at the time the fire occurred, and there were no injuries.

Responding units included Engines 1, 2 and 8, Medic 8A, Rescue 1, Battalion 1, EMS 1, Tanker 1, and Tanker 7 from the Holland Volunteer Fire Department, as well as Tanker 8 from the Whaleyville Volunteer Fire Department.

The Fire Marshal will investigate the cause of the fire.
