POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVES

SUFFOLK, VA (December 15, 2015) Two super load moves involving the hauling of mobile home units could cause delays in traffic Tuesday, December 15, 2015, between 9:45 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

The trucks will enter Suffolk from North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on the Franklin Bypass to eastbound Route 58 to Route 260/Great Mill Highway South to Route 189/South Quay Road and will end their journey in the 9800 block of South Quay Road.

Each truck and load will measure 14 feet tall, 15 feet wide, 100 feet long and will weigh 54,999 pounds.

The moves will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police escorts.
