ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (December 20, 2012) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, December 20, 2012, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Mineral Spring Road) – A contractor will have Mineral Spring Road closed between Freeman Mill Road and Whaleyville Boulevard, from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a detour in place routing thru traffic to Freeman Mill Road and Whaleyville Boulevard.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains. In conjunction with this project, a contractor will be performing soil borings on Route 58 along the edge of the eastbound lane. This work will require a flagging operation as it moves from the Holland Village back to Manning Bridge Road. The work is scheduled to be completed by January 4, 2013.

(Staley Drive) – A contractor working for the Public Utilities Line Maintenance Division will close Stanley Drive from Griggs Street to Route 58 to thru traffic from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Access to local businesses and home owners within the work zone will be provided.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 between the Chesapeake Line and Holland Road, as well as the Route 13/32 Bypass, until 3 p.m.

(Greenway Road) – A contractor for ditch maintenance will have a flagging operation on Greenway Road between Clover lane and the 700 block of Greenway Road until 3:30 p.m.

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor for ditch maintenance will have a flagging operation on Townpoint Road between Plummer Boulevard and Cove Street from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Milners Road) – A contractor for ditch maintenance will have a flagging operation on Milners Road between Lake Prince Drive and Girl Scout Road until 11 a.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.
