### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (February 13, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, February 13, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

#### **New Projects:**

(Route 10/Godwin Boulevard/Hillpoint Boulevard) – A contractor will have the outside lane of northbound Route 10/Godwin Boulevard closed on Thursday, February 14th. The right turn lane from Route 10/Godwin Boulevard to Hillpoint Boulevard will remain open. This closure will begin at 9:00 a.m. and extend through most of the day.

(N. Saratoga Street) - The Department of Public Utilities will be repairing a sewer lateral at 129 N. Saratoga Street on Thursday, February 14th. The work will require a detour of the southbound through traffic. Emergency access will be maintained.

## **Ongoing Projects:**

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.
