### **POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS – SUPER LOAD MOVES**

SUFFOLK, VA (February 14, 2016) Two separate super load moves could cause delays in traffic in Suffolk on Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup>.

The first load will involve a piece of equipment and is scheduled to move at 9 a.m. from the 300 block of Wellons Street to the 400 block of Wellons Street. The truck will travel from Wellons Street to Smith Street to South Saratoga Street to Wellons Street.

This truck and load will measure 13 feet 6 inches tall, 11 feet 6 inches wide, and 80 feet long.

The moves will have certified pilot cars along with Suffolk Police escorts.

The second load will involve steel girders and is scheduled to move between 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. The truck will travel from North Carolina to I-664 to Route 337/Nansemond Parkway to the 4500 block of Nansemond Parkway.
