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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (January 8, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, January 8, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Archers Mill Road) – A contractor will have Archers Mill Road closed from Kings Fork Road to Joshua Lane from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. for the replacement of a cross pipe.

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Townpoint Road from Plummer Boulevard to Cove Street until 3 p.m. for ditch maintenance.

(Indian Trail) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3600 block of Indian Trail until 3 p.m. for ditch maintenance.

(West Washington Street) – Suffolk Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have work zones at the following intersections from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.: West Washington Street at Lee Street and West Washington Street at South Street.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway. A lane closure will be in effect on Shoulders Hill Road between Count Crescent and the existing railroad tracks from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Flagging operations will be in place.

Ongoing Projects:

(Mineral Spring Road) – A contractor have Mineral Spring Road closed between Whaleyville Boulevard and Freeman Mill Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. this week. A detour will be in place to reroute thru traffic. This project is expected to continue through the end of January 2013.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains.

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
