TWO VEHICLES CRASH INTO BUILDING

SUFFOLK, VA (September 22, 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue are currently on the scene of an accident involving two passenger vehicles that crashed into a building in the 400 block of Carolina Road in downtown Suffolk.

Emergency Communications received the call at 3:05 p.m. advising of the accident that involved a Chrysler Sebring and Honda Accord. There were no occupants in the retail building, formerly Uptown Varieties, at the time of the accident.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment and 5 patients were ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries, including 3 males and 2 females.

Officials from Neighborhood Development Services will be inspecting the building, which sustained damage as a result of the accident.

All lanes of Carolina Road northbound were closed immediately following the accident. The left northbound lane is now open.

The investigation is ongoing as to the cause of the accident.
