DRIVER AIRLIFTED AFTER EARLY MORNING ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (December 3 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue were on the scene earlier this morning of an overturned passenger vehicle.

Emergency Communications received the call at 6:16 a.m. advising of the single vehicle accident in the 4900 block of Gardner Lane. Upon preliminary investigation it was found that the Chevrolet Suburban had left the roadway and rolled multiple times due to speed.

The adult male driver, the only occupant in the vehicle, was extricated by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and received emergency medical assessment and treatment. He was airlifted to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The cause of the accident is under investigation.
