FIREFIGHTERS RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (December 25, 2015) Suffolk Fire & Rescue crews responded to a residential structure fire in the 300 block of Cedar Street in downtown Suffolk this evening.

Emergency Communications received the call at 10:17 p.m. and the first units arrived on scene at 10:23 p.m.

Upon arrival firefighters found smoke and flames showing from the exterior of the two-story residence. The fire was called under control at 10:50 p.m. There were no injuries.

Responding units included Engines 1 and 2, Ladder 3, Rescue 1 and 6, Medic 1, Battalion 1, EMS-1 and the Fire Marshal.

Suffolk Police also responded and a portion of the roadway was briefly closed.

The cause of the fire is currently under investigation.
