## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (December 27, 2015) The roadway was completely reopened as of 6:15 a.m.

### **SUFFOLK POLICE AND SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (December 27, 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to a single vehicle accident on westbound Route 58 near the Virginia Department of Transportation Weigh Station this morning. Emergency Dispatch was notified of the accident at 3:33 a.m.

The Nissan Xterra left the roadway and struck a jersey wall with the driver of the vehicle being ejected from the vehicle. The male driver sustained life threatening injuries and was ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital following medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel. There were no other occupants of the vehicle.

The middle lane and right lane of westbound Route 58 are closed at this location. The far left lane is open at this time. The roadway is expected to be fully reopened in approximately 45 minutes.

The accident remains under investigation.
