SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE EMS PASSPORT PROGRAM

SUFFOLK, VA (February 17, 2016) The Suffolk Fire & Rescue Department is known for being there when citizens need their services. Part of that service includes providing EMS services along with the Nansemond Suffolk Volunteer Rescue Squad. The Suffolk Fire & Rescue Department's EMS Passport Subscription service offers a way to help citizens, and those who work in the City, defray out-of-pocket expenses, such as health insurance co-payments and deductibles, when they need emergency ambulance transportation.

Subscribers to the Passport program will not be charged for Suffolk Fire & Rescue or Nansemond Suffolk Volunteer Rescue Squad EMS transportation services as long as they are a current subscriber. For \$60 a year, a subscriber may enroll all members of his or her household. A residential subscription also includes family members of the subscriber listed on the application who reside in assisted-living or nursing facilities located in the City.
