UPDATE

Suffolk, VA (January 28, 2014) The two super load moves scheduled for today, Tuesday, January 28, 2014, have been cancelled due to the winter weather moving into our area today.

POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVES

SUFFOLK, VA (January 27, 2014) Two super load moves involving two separate units of a mobile home could cause delays in traffic Tuesday, January 28 around 1 p.m.

The trucks will travel through Suffolk starting in Southampton County, Virginia and concluding in the 9000 block of New Road in Suffolk. The route in Suffolk will cover the Franklin Bypass to Route 58 eastbound to Route 272 South/South Quay Road to Route 679/New Road.

Each truck and load will measure 15 feet 5 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 108 feet long, and weigh 73,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police Motor Carrier units.
