### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (January 28, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, January 28, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Jackson Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 300 to 450 block of Jackson Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closure on East Washington Street between Philhower Drive and Suburban Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Charles Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Charles Street between Jackson Street and Smith Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on westbound Route 58 between the scales and Bob Foeller Drive for guardrail repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Longstreet Lane between Mineral Spring Road and Quaker Road for shoulder repair from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Deer Path Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Deer Path Road between Chappell Drive and Route 58 for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 pm.

(Milford Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Milford Lane at Indian Trail Road for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Longstreet Lane between Mineral Spring Road and Quaker Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure in the 600 block of West Constance Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Townpoint Road at Hubbard Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Quaker Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Quaker Road between Longstreet Lane and Box Elder Road for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 460) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 2700 block of eastbound Route 460 for guardrail repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(County Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on County Street between East Washington Street and Polk Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Suffolk Police will have an Officer directing traffic at the intersection of County Street and East Washington Street.

(South Saratoga Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on South Saratoga Street between Smith Street and Jackson Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Jackson Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Jackson Street between South Saratoga Street and Charles Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Pittmantown Road) – Beginning January 4, 2016, a contractor will have the 2900 block to 3300 block of Pittmantown Road closed to perform a pipe replacement. A detour will be in place diverting all thru traffic onto Short Lane/Reynoldson Road to Lees Mill Road/Robbie Road. Residents in the work area will have full access to their property. The project is expected to be completed by February 5<sup>th</sup>.

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will have Katherine Street closed between East Pinner Street and East Constance Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

(Prentis Street) – A contractor will have Prentis Street closed to thru traffic between Main Street and Pine Street. Traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. City, Emergency and Resident access will be accommodated. The closure will be in effect for 24 hours a day until further notice.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice.

(Tyson Court) – Tyson Court will be closed to all traffic entering and exiting the Public Works Operations Center in 800 block of Carolina Road. This closure will be in place for approximately 60 days while the new entrance is constructed. All vehicles will enter and exit via the traffic signal at 800 Carolina Road. Accommodations have been made to allow a left turn at the traffic signal.
