## **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY CAMP TAKING APPLICATIONS**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 3, 2016) The Suffolk Department of Fire & Rescue has kicked off its campaign for applications for their Summer Fire and Life Safety Camps to be held at several stations throughout the City for children ages 6 to 9.

The camp is a half-day local camp that runs Monday through Friday and features a variety of fun, challenging, entertaining, and educational activities. The mission of the camp is to teach children safety lessons on things around their homes and schools which they encounter every day. Short lectures and lessons are followed by opportunities to actively participate in exercises designed to reinforce the topics. Topics include firefighting, bike safety, water safety, search & rescue practices, first aid, and much more.

The fee for each weekly session is \$85 per child which includes a camp t-shirt, various school supplies, and lunch each day except for Friday when there will be a graduation for participants. Participants can arrive as early as 7:30 a.m. and must be picked up by 1 p.m. The sessions run from 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and 8:30 a.m. until 12 p.m. on Friday. Transportation to and from the camp is not provided.

The sessions and locations are as follows:

Session 1, July 25 – July 29, Station #5, 3901 Bridge Road

Session 2, August 1 – August 5, Station #6, 300 Kings Fork Road

Session 3, August 15 – August 19, Station #6, 300 Kings Fork Road

The registration deadline is June 17, 2016 for all three camps. You may mail or drop off the application and fee to: Suffolk Fire & Rescue Fire Camp, 300 Kings Fork Road, Suffolk, VA 23434. Checks will need to be made out to the Jeff T. Messinger Memorial Fund. Space is limited and camps will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Participants will not be confirmed for the camp until the application and payment are received.
