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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 13, 2012) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, July 13, 2012, due to construction and maintenance projects:

**New Projects:**

-Lee Street, between West Washington Street and Jackson Street, will be closed to thru traffic from 7:30 a.m. until 5 p.m. All thru traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. City, Emergency, and Resident access will be accommodated as needed. This closure will be in effect during working hours only.

-A contractor on Nansemond Parkway will have lane closures with flagging operations between Helen Street and Shoulders Hill Road between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday, July 9 through Friday, July 13.

-City of Suffolk Public Works will have a flagging operation on Butler Drive for pavement repair during business hours.

-A contractor will be removing and replacing the concrete bridge deck overlay material at the Mills Godwin Bridge, Route 17/Bridge Road. The work zone will be in effect from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The work project is expected to last 90 days, weather permitting, with flagging operations in place during work hours.

-A contractor will be working on Pittmantown Road and Arthur Drive through Friday until 5:30 p.m. each day. The majority of the work will be on the shoulders, but selected sections may require flagging operations.

-A contractor maintaining vegetation will be working on the Route 58 Bypass from the Route 13 Bypass to the Chesapeake line.

-City of Suffolk Public Works will have a shoulder closure in the right turn lane on North Main Street in front of the Fire Mountain Restaurant until 12 p.m.

-A City of Suffolk Public Works Traffic Signal crew will have a short term stationary work zone affecting the northbound left thru lane on Main Street and the eastbound outside left turn lane on Constance Road from 7 a.m. until 11 a.m. on Sunday, July 15, 2012. This work is to install a traffic monitoring camera on the traffic signal mast arm.

**Ongoing Projects:**

-Contractors will have the inside westbound lane and the outside eastbound lane of Route 58 closed from near Raleigh Drive to the 2400 block of Route 58/Holland Road including the intersection of Manning Bridge Road from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. to provide a safe work zone. This closure is for right of way work within the median. The left turn lane onto Manning Bridge Road will remain open.

-Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Route 10 between Everett's Road and Kings Highway until 3 p.m. This work zone is an ongoing project set for completion by the Summer of 2012.

-A contractor will continue with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

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
