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UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (June 6, 2013) - Public Works will have a mobile operation in the outside lane on Route 58 West between Brentwood Rd. and Holy neck Rd. until 3:00 p.m.

Also, Please be advised there will be a new traffic pattern heading Southbound on Shoulders Hill Road between Count Crescent and Nansemond Parkway starting this afternoon.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 6, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, June 6, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Route 58) – A Contractor will be maintaining vegetation along Route 58 from the 13/32 Bypass to the Chesapeake line.

(Holland Rd./Route 58) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the outside westbound lane from the 3200 to the 3300 block of Holland Rd. (Route 58) from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

(Route 58 West) – A contractor will have a left westbound lane closure for 2 miles on Route 58 starting at the Nansemond Parkway Bridge. This lane closure will be in place until 3:00 p.m.

(Holland Corner Rd.) – A contractor will be replacing a cross pipe on Holland Corner Rd. today between Quaker Dr. and Mineral Springs Rd. A detour is in place to route thru traffic. This closure will be in effect until 4:00 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Public Works will have Bank St. Extended closed to thru traffic between Halifax St. and Lloyd St. until 3:00 p.m. today. Resident and Emergency vehicle access will be provided.

(Kings Hwy) – A Traffic Engineering paint crew will have a flagging operation at the intersection of Kings Hwy. and Crittenden Rd. until 2:00 p.m.

(Harbour View Blvd.) – A contractor will be working on the shoulder of the road along Harbour View Blvd. from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM today.

(Bridge Rd.) – A contractor will be working on the right hand shoulder of Bridge Rd. from Walden Rd. to Knotts Neck Rd. until 4:00 p.m.

(Driver Ln.) – Public Works will have a mobile operation on Driver Ln. from Patrick Dr. to Bennetts Pasture Rd. until 12:00 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Route 10/Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound shoulder closure on Route 10/Godwin Boulevard between the Reids Ferry Bridge and 1000 feet north of the Pump Station. They will also have a lane closure in the northbound lane from Sack Point Road to Harrell Drive from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. This pipe installation project will continue for the next three to five months.

The contractor will also have a lane closure in the outside northbound lane on Godwin Boulevard 1000 feet before the two lanes of traffic merge to one. This closure will be in effect day and night for the next 3 weeks while large sections of pipe are being installed.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) – A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway. Expect delays through this work zone until further notice. The contractor will have lane closures with flagging operations between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. from June 3rd through June 8th. The contractor will be paving asphalt throughout the construction site and heavy traffic patterns are anticipated.

(Market Street & Henley Place) – Thru traffic on Market Street and Henley Place will be restricted until June 28, 2013, to facilitate additional pavement and concrete work for the City of Suffolk E-911/Municipal Center project. The west entrance to the Main Municipal Center Parking Lot will be closed. All public and staff traffic to the Human Resources Building will utilize the same entrance and travel along the north side of the parking lot to the building. Access to the Human Resources Building can also happen via Washington Street to Pender Street on the west side of the Police Administration Building.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains. The expected completion date is September 2013.

(Pruden Boulevard & Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.

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
