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UPDATE

(Route 32) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on northbound Route 32 between Adams Swamp Road and Cypress Chapel Road for milling from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 6, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, June 6, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on northbound North Main Street from the 1200 block to the 1600 block from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m., June 6th through June 10th.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a northbound shoulder closure in the 1700 block of North Main Street between Beach Ford and Northgate Lane from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 6th through June 10th.

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Charlotte Avenue closed between Spruce Street and Laurel Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Harbourview Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound lane shift in the 6000 block of Harbourview Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 6th through June 9th.

(Manning Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Manning Road between Holland Road and Copeland Road for ditch maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 32) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on northbound Route 32 between Adams Swamp Road and Cypress Chapel Road for milling from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile lane closure on eastbound Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Wilroy Road exit for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Everets Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 5800 block of Everets Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lake Kilby Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Sign and Paint Crew will have a flagging operation on Kings Fork Road between Godwin Boulevard and Boundary Drive from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Brewer Avenue) – A contractor will perform an emergency gravity sewer line replacement and manhole replacement on Brewer Avenue. A flagging operation will maintain traffic at the intersection of 2nd Avenue and Brewer Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 6th through June 10th. Residential traffic and emergency vehicles on Brewer Avenue will be accommodated as needed.

(Old Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works has closed Old Mill Road at the bridge due to high water until further notice.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 1600 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Everets Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Everets Road closed between Lake Prince Drive and Moore Farm Lane from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., June 7th thru June 8th, for bridge maintenance. A detour will be in place with a variable message board posted to alert residents of the upcoming road work.

Ongoing Projects:

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will have Katherine Street closed between East Pinner Street and East Constance Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice.

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
