SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE FIRE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 19, 2015) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to a report of a commercial structure fire in the 1000 block of East Washington Street at A & A Open Market last night. Emergency Dispatchers were notified of the incident at 9:23 p.m.

The first units arrived on scene at 9:26 p.m. and found what was described as a very small fire on the exterior of the vacant building. The fire was marked under control at 9:48 p.m. There were no injuries.

Battalion 1, Engine 3, Ladder 3, Engine 2, Rescue 1, Medic 1A, and Engine 4 responded to the scene.

The Fire Marshal's Office is handling the investigation as the cause of the fire is considered suspicious at this time.
