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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 28, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, June 28, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed to thru traffic until 4 p.m. Resident and Emergency vehicle access will be provided.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard between Oakland Elementary School and Kings Highway until 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road/Mills Godwin Bridge) – A contractor will utilize a flagging operation at the Bridge Road/Mills Godwin Bridge Sunday through Thursday. This will be night work taking place from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather permitting.

(Kings Highway) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure on Kings Highway from the Chuckatuck Volunteer Fire Department to the Public Works Facility/Crittenden Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 26 through June 28 and July 1 through July 2.

(Holland Corner Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will have Holland Corner Road closed between Quaker Drive and Mineral Spring Road from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. A detour will be in place to route through traffic.

(East Constance Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure on East Constance Road from Elizabeth Street to Wilroy Road until 1 p.m.

(Indian Trail) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Indian Trail between Lake Meade Drive and Lake Cohoon Road until 12 p.m.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Mineral Spring Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and Freeman Mill Road from 7 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 460/Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a right westbound lane closure on Route 460/Pruden Boulevard from the Route 58 off ramp (to Route 460) to Isle of Wight County until 3:30 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will be maintaining vegetation along Route 58 from the Route 13/32 Bypass to the Chesapeake line.

Ongoing Projects:

(Everetts Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a flagging operation with the right lane closed on Everetts Road from the 6500 block to Moore Farm Lane from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, for the next six months.

(Route 10/Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound shoulder closure on Route 10/Godwin Boulevard between the Reids Ferry Bridge and 1000 feet north of the Pump Station. They will also have a lane closure in the northbound lane from Sack Point Road to Harrell Drive from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. This pipe installation project will continue for the next three to five months. The contractor will also have a lane closure in the outside northbound lane on Godwin Boulevard 1000 feet before the two lanes of traffic merge to one. This closure will be in effect day and night for the next 3 weeks while large sections of pipe are being installed.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) – A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway. Expect delays through this work zone until further notice. The contractor will have lane closures with flagging operations in various locations throughout the project area from June 24 to June 28 between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

(Market Street & Henley Place) – Thru traffic on Market Street and Henley Place will be restricted until further notice to facilitate additional pavement and concrete work for the City of Suffolk E-911/Municipal Center project. The west entrance to the Main Municipal Center Parking Lot will be closed. All public and staff traffic to the Human Resources Building will utilize the same entrance and travel along the north side of the parking lot to the building. Access to the Human Resources Building can also happen via Washington Street to Pender Street on the west side of the Police Administration Building.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains. The expected completion date is September 2013.

(Pruden Boulevard) - A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from Meade Parkway to the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard (Pump Station) until 3:00 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed. The closure is required immediately in front of the site due to equipment and material deliveries.

(North Main Street) - A contractor installing a sewer force main will have a lane closure in the right eastbound lane on North Main Street between Edgewood Avenue and Holly Lawn Cemetery from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. nightly this week.

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
