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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (March 4, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, March 4, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Crittenden Road) – A contractor will have the northbound lane closed (right lane as you are heading to Bridge Road) on Crittenden Road between the intersection of Kings Highway and Ferry Point Road from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have the right shoulder closed on the Route 13/32 Bypass on ramp to Route 58 westbound from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various Roadways) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Roadway Maintenance Crews will have mobile operations throughout the City as they patch and fill potholes from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor is performing emergency work at the intersection of Bridge Road and Crittenden Road. They have Crittenden Road closed at this intersection.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will be working on Pitchkettle Road between Lake Kilby Road and the Route 58 intersection from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.

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
