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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (March 6, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, March 6, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 in the area of the Wilroy Road exit and the Nansemond River Bridge from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.

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
