(March 21, 2016) The move of the mobile home has been rescheduled for Tuesday, March 22, 2016 around 9:45 a.m.

The move will follow the original route of northbound Route 32 to northbound Route 13 to the Route 13/32 Bypass to the Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass to westbound Route 460 and will end the trip in Windsor, Virginia.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as a Suffolk Police escort.

## **POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 17, 2016) A super load move, involving the hauling of a mobile home, could cause delays in traffic around 9:45 a.m., Friday, March 18, 2016.

The truck will begin its journey in North Carolina and will travel through Suffolk on northbound Route 32 to northbound Route 13 to the Route 13/32 Bypass to the Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass to westbound Route 460 and will end the trip in Windsor, Virginia.

The truck and load will measure 13 feet 6 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 76 feet long, and weigh 40,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as a Suffolk Police escort.
