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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (March 18, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, March 18, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Route 10/Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will be maintaining vegetation Route 10/Godwin Boulevard.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Mineral Spring Road closed between Sumner Street and Robertson Street from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. A detour is in place to route thru traffic. This work will continue through the end of this week.

(West Washington Street) – The right lane heading west on West Washington Street, between Pelham Place and Military Road, will be closed. Traffic will be reduced to one thru lane Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. for 4 days. Traffic control will be in place during the working hours and will be removed from the streets each day until project completion. City, Emergency, and Resident access will be accommodated as needed.

Ongoing Projects:

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains. The expected completion date is September 2013.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.

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
