## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (April 29, 2015) Suffolk Police advise that the involved vehicles have been removed from the roadway and all lanes have reopened to through traffic.

The cause of the accident remains under investigation.

## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (April 29, 2015) Suffolk Police advise that each of the three involved vehicles were occupied by the driver only.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment and two males and one female were ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway is expected to remain closed until the vehicles and debris can be removed from the roadway.

The cause of the accident is under investigation.

## **THREE VEHICLE ACCIDENT CLOSSES GODWIN BRIDGE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (April 29, 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue are currently on the scene of a three vehicle accident in the 2200 block of Bridge Road on the Mills E. Godwin Bridge.

Emergency Communications received the call at 6:22 a.m.

The roadway is currently shut down in both directions. The accident involved two passenger vehicles and a pick-up truck. Unknown as to extent of injuries or any other details at this time. Preliminary information provided for traffic-related issues only. An updated release will follow.
