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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 28, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, March 28, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be working southbound in the 800 block of Carolina Road daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work will periodically require a southbound left shoulder or lane closure.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure in the 6800 block of Harbour View Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Hosier Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation in the 1900 block of Hosier Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Hillpoint Boulevard) – A contractor will have the inside lane and median closed westbound on Hillpoint Boulevard between Gunston Drive and Hillpoint Woods from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 100 block of East Washington Street to perform a manhole rehabilitation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a right shoulder closure in the 2800 block of Pruden Boulevard from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(South Quay Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on South Quay Road between Gates Road and Stuart Drive for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Shoulders Hill Road for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Arthur Drive and Boonetown Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 4300 to 4800 blocks of Nansemond Parkway for litter control from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Highway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Kings Highway between Bennetts Pasture Road and Sleepy Hole Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(James Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have James Avenue closed between Respass Beach Road and Hoffler Street Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for storm drain installations. Work is expected to be complete by April 31<sup>st</sup>, weather dependent.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be working within the City of Suffolk for approximately 3 weeks, weather dependent, from March 20<sup>th</sup> through April 10<sup>th</sup>. The contractor will perform pavement condition assessments of the City's roadway network. The operation will not interfere with traffic or pedestrians.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure northbound on College Drive between the entrance to Jersey Mike's Subs and Lake View Parkway near the I-664 exit and the right turn lane onto Lake View Parkway. The contractor will also have the left turn lane onto northbound College Drive on Hampton Roads Parkway closed from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily until March 31<sup>st</sup>.

(Grove Avenue and Delaney Drive) – A contractor will be installing the HRSD force main on Grove Avenue and Delaney Drive requiring occasional detours and lane closures. Work is scheduled to begin December 19<sup>th</sup> and estimated to be complete in March 2017. Work hours will be 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

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
