POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE

SUFFOLK, VA (March 30, 2017) A super load move involving the hauling of a swimming pool could cause delays in traffic Friday, March 31, 2017, between 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

The truck will begin the journey in North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on eastbound Route 460 to the Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass to northbound Route 10/32 to Godwin Boulevard to Kings Highway ending in the 1500 block of Kings Highway.

The truck and load will measure 13 feet 6 inches tall, 15 feet wide, 70 feet long, and weigh 36,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police escorts.
