ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 11, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, May 11, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound in the inside lane on Route 58 from the Pitchkettle Road exit to the 6-lanes continuing westbound in the inside lane from the Chesapeake city line to the Route 13/32 Bypass from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 6000 block of Kings Fork Road for asphalt repair from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Suburban Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Suburban Drive for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Glen Haven Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 1200 block of Glen Haven Drive for a cross drain repair from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Various Sites) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard, Godwin Boulevard and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be working northbound in the 800 block of Carolina Road daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work will periodically require a northbound left shoulder or lane closure.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.
