ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 17, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, May 17, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between the Southampton County line and the Route 13/32 Bypass for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holy Neck Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Holy Neck Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Longstreet Lane between Dutch Road and Quince Road for milling and paving from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road, College Drive, Hampton Roads Parkway, Shoulders Hill Road, Nansemond Parkway, and Godwin Boulevard spraying guardrails and medians from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have the right turn lane closed on College Drive at Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road until noon continuing to Whaleyville Boulevard until 5 p.m. for vegetation maintenance.

Ongoing Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be working northbound in the 800 block of Carolina Road daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work will periodically require a northbound left shoulder or lane closure.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.
