### **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE AND SUFFOLK POLICE RESPOND TO SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (November 15, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to a single vehicle accident in the 1200 block of Glen Haven Road this evening. Emergency Dispatch received a call at 7:22 p.m. notifying of the accident.

A pickup truck reportedly attempted to avoid hitting a deer when the vehicle went off the road into a ditch and overturned. The two occupants were able to get out of the vehicle before units arrived. Both received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel at the scene. The passenger was airlifted via Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The driver was ground transported by the Nansemond-Suffolk Volunteer Rescue Squad to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue Engine 7 and EMS 1 along with Nansemond-Suffolk Volunteer Rescue Squad Medic 42A responded to the scene.

The roadway was closed for a short period of time following the accident.
