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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 24, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, May 24, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(College Drive) – A contractor will have the northbound right turn lane closed on College Drive at Lakeview Parkway for a sidewalk installation daily from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., May 18th through June 9th.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 Overpass and Burnetts Way from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 22nd through May 26th.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a right lane closure eastbound on Godwin Boulevard at Kensington Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 23rd through May 26th.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 and the Route 13/32 Bypass for sweeping from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 eastbound and westbound between the Southampton County line to the Route 13/32 Bypass for debris pickup from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Suburban Drive) – Suburban Drive will be closed to thru traffic between Portsmouth Boulevard and East Washington Street for railroad crossing repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Thursday, May 25th.

(East Washington Street) – East Washington Street will be closed to thru traffic between Suburban Drive and Portsmouth Boulevard for railroad crossing repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Friday, May 26th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be working southbound in the 800 block of Carolina Road daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work will periodically require a southbound left shoulder or lane closure.

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(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

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
